and do you desire forgiveness in his name? I do.

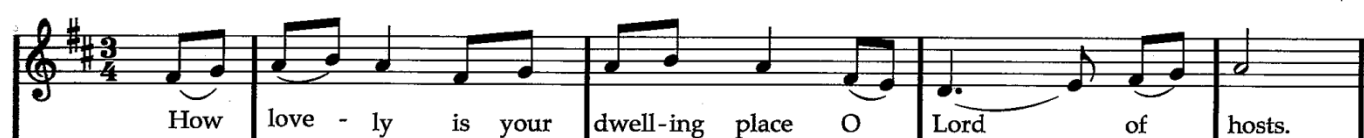
P: Do you intend with the help of the Holy Spirit to live as in God's
